Exhibition: Art Beyond Borders

Discover how art crosses spatial, temporal and cultural boundaries in Art Beyond Borders., the Exhibition. Students explore how artists use the visual arts to communicate cultural influences and how artists have responded to the impact of major world events through their art over time.

AFTERNOON

Studio: Curating Collections

Students are introduced to curatorial practices and exhibition construction as they examine current exhibitions in the AGA Collection. Through a series of Gallery discussions and activities, students identify artistic subject matter and themes, experiment with mixed media techniques and *create a series of miniature works reflective of their own experiences*. Finally, students work to select, interpret, and re-interpret their images as they develop a collective curatorial statement.
