Students who demonstrate responsible work habits and high levels of motivation can complete a high school diploma through the Knowledge and Employability route in three years by taking a fifth core in both their grade 11 and 12 years. They would enroll in either English 30-4 or Social 20-2 during the second semester of their grade 11 year. This would allow them to enroll in English 30-2 and Social 30-2 in each of the semesters of their grade 12 year, thus completing all diploma requirements in three years.
